



Top Tips for Transition



Have a meeting with new parents in June/July with important Information.

Visit the children in their pre- school setting in June/July

Do a home visit in September if possible.

.....into Reception

Meet with pre school leaders to discuss individual children's records.

Meet with parents to give them the opportunity to tell you about their child.

New children to spend time in Reception class in July.

Children have a staggered entry to allow them to learn routines etc.

Talk about the children's Foundation Stage Profiles with Y1 teacher before September!

Meet with the Y1 teacher in June/July to discuss the children's needs/issues.

Y1 classroom to have similar layout to Reception classroom for Term 1 at least.

and out of Reception.....

Have similar resources such as self registration, visual timetable, number lines, phonics etc,

Y1 teacher to visit children in Term 6 for story time once a week.

Discuss with parents about their child moving into Y1 and any changes that will be happening.
