Dear Colleagues,

I am sending this as a reminder to schools about the opportunities for ICT support being offered through our networks this year. If you are interested in being involved please could you e-mail me asap as the first two networks being at the end of next week.

I have attached the complete list of networks which details what they plan to address and the proposed dates.

One of the networks is looking particularly into developing the use of our progressions scheme of work for ICT developed through working with schools. This has been developed as a replacement for the QCA scheme of work, to address the increased attainment required by the primary frameworks and to include greater emphasis on multimedia work. The final versions also include learning outcomes and assessment activities which will support any schools needing to address assessment in ICT. It has previously been presented at Best Practice Forum in earlier draft forms. I have attached these latest versions for your information as I know many schools are now looking towards using this for teaching ICT. The progressions network will also look in to how ICT can be incorporated into the school curriculum and will also support schools with looking at curriculum mapping.

This work was based around a starting point suggested by the primary strategy but never completed. It covers the strands of communicating information, handling information, control, modelling and research and acceptable use. There is also an e-safety strand covering acceptable use of ICT and I would recommend you consider this if you have not yet implemented and e-safety teaching programme.

I am repeating the internet safety workshops from last year if e-safety is a concern for your school. These are being repeated on 21st October and 5th November. Again, please e-mail me if you would like someone to be booked on to one of these sessions.

Please get back to me if you have any queries about any of the above.
