Multiple Intelligences	Emerson Green	Music being used as 'rituals' throughout school (establish routine) Music for different times of day - same music at beginning of day for block of time to help children feel secure. Set music pieces for different times of the day - establish routine
Multiple Intelligences	Frampton	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ▪ Music as the children come in for a new session ▪ Music for different parts of the day
Multiple Intelligences	Gillingstool St Stephens Hanham Abbots	Using music in the lesson to create appropriate mood – story settings linked in Use music at start of day during registration and bellwork Playing music at tidy up time in reception (flight of bumblebee) As a 'timer' for tidying up
Multiple Intelligences	Hanham Abbots Junior School, Pucklechurch	Brain gym, alphabet, x tables Changing for gym Music to come in with, used as a 'timer' for tidying up
Multiple Intelligences	Highcroft	Music playing in the background while pupils are working
Multiple Intelligences	Horton	Used photos as a slideshow - for the seasons used music (the Four Seasons to accompany photos for literacy)
Multiple Intelligences	King Edmunds Community School	Use of music to set a mood e.g. Play classical music during 'quiet time' work
Multiple Intelligences	Old Sodbury	Music to create moods Introduction of music when doing certain class activities
Multiple Intelligences	Old Sodbury	Bought and used CD (can't remember title!) music linked to learning activities.
Multiple Intelligences	Ridings High	Use of music during review and starter/Brain Gym

Multiple Intelligences	Rodford	Music to work to 'creative thinking' 'Countdown' music for thinking time 'Whistle while you work' music to tidy up to (reception)
Multiple Intelligences	Samual Whites Infant School	Music playing in classroom during wet playtime - calmer atmosphere
Multiple Intelligences	St Stephens Infants Yr 1	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ▪ In the mornings to signal it is time to tidy up ▪ During golden time to keep the noise level down
Multiple Intelligences	Warmley Park	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ▪ Use of music – mission impossible theme tune for tidying up with time limit. ▪ Pupils choose music for other routine times e.g. am drinks ▪ Used at start of lesson (helps to have the lights off)
