### Page 20 – Overall description for a Band 2 School

#### **Add**

The school's recent Ofsted inspection judged the overall effectiveness of the school to be satisfactory. The majority of judgements for achievement, quality of provision and leadership and management are either satisfactory or inadequate.

### Page 23 – Section 2.6 - Notifying Schools

#### **Replace the first paragraph with**

Concerns may arise at any time in a school when the level of support it requires needs to be increased. When concerns are identified by the Local Authority they will be drawn to the attention of the Headteacher and Chair of Governors promptly. One example of concern may be as a result of an Ofsted inspection. Schools where the judgement for overall effectiveness is satisfactory will be provided with Band 2 support in order to ensure that they can further develop their capacity to deal with the issues raised and that they are not vulnerable to an early re-visit by Ofsted. Alternatively, schools may, through their own self-evaluation, have identified a need for additional support in specific areas. In the first instance, they will discuss this with their School Improvement Partner.
